



Water Service Interruption Notice

Hillsboro Beach Residents

Between 1125 and 1205 Hillsboro Mile Only

For the period from May 29th to June 8th, water service will be interrupted, one residence at a time, for up to four hours as water service for each residence is switched between the primary water main and a temporary main. Each residence will be notified 48 hours in advance as to when this will occur. **There is no need to boil your water during this event** since the existing water mains have not lost pressure.



As you know, the water main construction project is underway. During this process, the Contractor will be replacing or lining the existing water mains. To avoid a more lengthy interruption of your water service, your water service will be placed onto a temporary (bypass) water line that runs over ground in front of your property, or if previously switched to the bypass line, will now be switched back. While we move your service from the existing water main to the temporary bypass line, your water service will be temporarily interrupted*.

While the service is interrupted, avoid turning on faucets to prevent air entering the system. Once the service is returned, you may hear a “knocking” in your plumbing which is a result of air having entered the system. This can be removed by opening a faucet inside the home until the knocking subsides.

If your residence wasn’t previously switched to the bypass line, this is being done at this time. Your water service will again be interrupted later in the project to move your service back to the permanent main when it is put back into service. You will receive separate notice for that interruption.
